The page, dwelling and family numbering was done separately for Camano Island and Whidbey Island. Camano Island is presented first, then Whidbey Island, following the order of the stamped page numbers. The post office at Utsalady served not only Camano Island, but also the Skagit precinct of Whatcom County and the Stillaguamish precinct of Snohomish County. The latter two are not included in this census transcription.

There is no guarantee as to the accuracy of this transcription. The hand-writing of the enumerator is sometimes difficult to read. Where there is doubt about a word a question mark has been inserted. Although this transcription has been double checked, errors may still exist. Findings here should be checked with the original for confirmation.
